## HAWS ART CONTEST RULES & GUIDELINES

1. The contest is open to youth who are in Kindergarten through Post High School.
2. Value categories judged will be: Joy/Laughter, Friendship/Companionship, Love/Kindness, Loyalty, Nurturing.
3. Age categories will be as follows: Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 5<sup>th</sup> grade through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, high school, post high school.
4. A winner from each age and in each value category will be chosen. Winners will receive a ribbon and have their artwork framed and displayed at the Waukesha County Historical Society and Museum in conjunction of *The Nature of Dogs* exhibit between April and June 2010.
5. The winning artwork will be displayed at HAWS after the exhibit. While it will not be returned to the artist, a color photocopy may be requested and given to the artist.
6. All artwork must be original work. **Artwork should be either 8x10 or 11x14 in size-no exceptions.** Acceptable media are paint, pencil, markers, ink, crayon, chalk or pastel (fixed), photography, cloth, collage and computer art.

All entries must contain the student's name, school, city and state and value being represented **on the back** — via a completed entry form. Please attach the entry form with tape or other fixative (if using glue, be careful to use one that will not run through and damage the artwork) — also, do not use paperclips! **We will not accept color copies—all entries must be original work.**

7. Art entries must be done on paper that will allow for duplication, display or framing. Please, no notebook paper, and **do not mat, mount, laminate, frame or fold artwork.** Entries must be mailed flat or rolled in a tube— no folding, please!
8. Submissions become property of HAWS. Through submission of artwork, contestants and their legal guardians grant non-exclusive reproduction and publication rights to the works submitted which will not be returned.
9. **DEADLINE: All entries must be received at HAWS on or before March 15, 2010.** Submissions may be mailed or dropped off at HAWS at 701 Northview Road, Waukesha, WI 53188. We are not responsible for entries that are late or lost in the mail.
10. Winners will be announced on HAWS' website ([www.hawspets.org](http://www.hawspets.org)) by March 29, 2010.
