**WAUKESHA – January 3, 2019.** The Humane Animal Welfare Society (**HAWS**) wastes no time jumping right into the action in 2019!

**Wings of Rescue landing at HAWS:** This Saturday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, a flight originating in New Mexico and Texas will bring over 100 dogs to Crites Field in Waukesha. Sponsored by FreeKibble.com, GreaterGood.org and Wings of Rescue, HAWS and shelter partners Elmbrook Humane Society, Jefferson County Humane Society, Watertown Humane Society and Washington County Humane Society will have the dogs available for adoption within the coming weeks. ***Flight arrival time to be determined on Saturday; HAWS' transport coordinator Jessica Pinkos will be available Saturday to confirm at 414-587-7200, prior to 3pm.***
