**Mistakes happen...that’s life!** In order to alleviate stress and more quickly reunite pets and their people, HAWS has announced a pilot program, waiving redemption and pick-up fees for **first-time stray pets** through July 2019. To qualify, pets must be reclaimed within 24 hours of arrival at HAWS, and be spayed or neutered. Pets will get a free HAWS tag and personalized I.D. tag. *Individual municipalities may still have fees or redemption requirements; owners should call HAWS prior to picking up their pet. HAWS’ SNIP clinic services are available for those pets not already spayed or neutered; call 262-542-8851, x109 for an appointment.*
