For the fourth year in a row, HAWS is participating with a group of animal shelters in Wisconsin, entirely waiving adoption fees for all adult cats in July. ## Please remember these important pet safety tips for the summer:

- Leave pets securely at home, indoors, during fireworks shows or extreme weather. Never leave pets outside unattended, even in a fenced yard. Air conditioning or fans provide soothing background noise and comfort.
- Never leave pets unattended in a parked car. The temperature inside a vehicle, even with windows open, can climb more than 30 degrees per minute depending on conditions. Plus, keep off hot, dark asphalt whenever possible when on walks, to avoid burns to sensitive paw pads.
- Make sure your pet has I.D. both tags and a microchip with current contact information. Keep pictures of your pet and vet records on your phone for easy reference and identification. Microchips are available at HAWS, 7 days a week, no appointment necessary!
