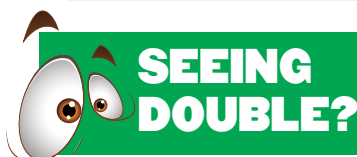


WAYS TO GIVE

Paying It Forward: Always Appreciated!

HAWS' Education team provides a wide array of activities, clubs and opportunities for children to learn about animals, as well as the values of empathy, kindness and compassion. Some of these programs are free, others do require tuition or participation fees.

Each year, local and not-so-local businesses offer scholarships to sponsor kids that might not otherwise be able to attend our Kids 'N Critters Day Camps. It is always exciting to let a child know they can come to camp!

We have had a few instances recently of private citizens wanting to pay the camp fees for a deserving child. In one particular case, a child needed to cancel attending camp; rather than receiving a refund, the parents chose to pay it forward and asked that money be used for another camper.

The kids certainly get excited about these "big" things, but they also find gratitude in the little things as well! The stuffed animal handed out at one of our birthday parties, the chance to pet the goats and feed the horses at our Schallock Center, the ability to handle an animal they've never been in close contact with before – these things light up faces and make our staff and volunteers smile, too, as we watch.

Sustained by Community Gifts

HAWS' Spay-Neuter Initiative Program clinic, along with our Project Guardian and Seeking Sanctuary alternative adoptions, are all greatly supported and maintained by our community. Eliminating pet overpopulation while ending needless euthanasia is a goal that most can agree is worthwhile achieving.

Along with spay/neuter services, HAWS' SNIP also aims to ensure all patients are healthy for the longer term. 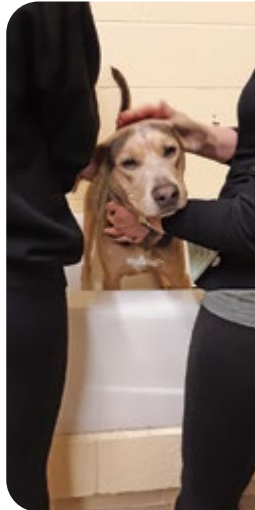

The special bathtubs in our grooming room are a great way to welcome new dogs to HAWS. Transport pups looking for a fresh new start get a spa treatment including a bath, a massage and a message that everything is going to be alright! Watching them melt into the warm, comfy care of a wonderful volunteer is priceless.

Small size scales for kittens and puppies, and warming brooders have made a world of difference for our lifesaving capabilities with very young litters! Brooders can keep neonates at just the right temperature (unlike a heating pad), and scales paired with daily weigh-ins can let us know something might be wrong - before we can see other symptoms!

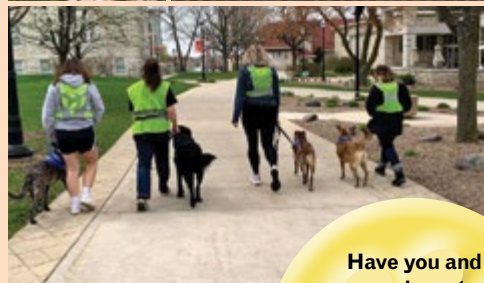
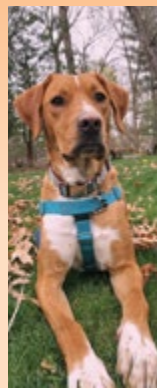

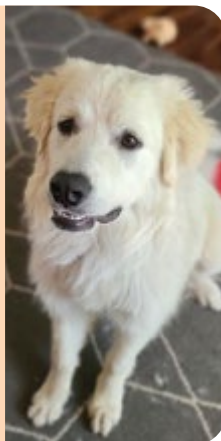


ROLO & CARMELLO

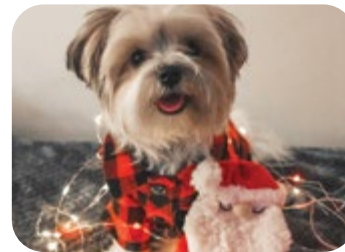
