## HAWS NAMED ONE OF TOP THREE NATIONAL CHARITIES; ADVANCES TO FINAL ROUND OF CHARITY NAVIGATOR AWARD VOTING

Waukesha animal center recognized for commitment to community

WAUKESHA – August 30, 2023. After the preliminary round of voting, <u>HAWS</u>, the Humane Animal Welfare Society of Waukesha County, has been named one of the top three finalists in the largesize division for <u>Charity Navigator's 2023 Community Choice Awards!</u>

Charity Navigator is the nation's largest and most influential nonprofit evaluator; the Community Choice Awards spotlight top-rated charities that resonate most with people's passions. The nomination is the result of HAWS' four-star rating, having earned all four Charity Navigator beacons, and, most importantly, making a difference in the cause of animal welfare and humane education throughout Waukesha County and beyond.

The final round of voting begins today, August 30th and concludes on September 8th. The Community Choice Awards will have one winner in each size-based category - winners will be based on the total number of votes received. The winners will be officially announced on September 27th. As a winning charity, HAWS would receive prominent visibility on Charity Navigator for one year and with Navigator's audience of donors, dedicated posts on Charity Navigator's social media, as well as other opportunities to share the importance of animal welfare and nurturing a humane community.
