HAWS NOMINATED FOR CHARITY NAVIGATOR COMMUNITY CHOICE AWARD

Waukesha animal center recognized for commitment to positive impact, transparency

WAUKESHA – August 17, 2023. HAWS, the Humane Animal Welfare Society of Waukesha County, is excited to announce our nomination for Charity Navigator's 2023 Community Choice Awards, spotlighting top-rated charities that resonate most with people's passions. Charity Navigator is the nation's largest and most influential nonprofit evaluator.

HAWS is one of only three charities in Wisconsin to be nominated, and one of only six animal welfare charities. This nomination is the result of HAWS' four-star rating, having earned all four Charity Navigator beacons, and, most importantly, making a difference in the cause of animal welfare and humane education throughout our community and beyond.

"Our entire team is excited to receive this nomination," said HAWS Executive Director Lynn Olenik. "It means the world to us to not only be able to impact the lives of pets and their people, but that the importance of our work also resonates within our community. Together we are accomplishing great things, and this award will enable us to save and change even more lives."

The top three vote-earning charities in each of the four categories will advance to the final round of voting, August 30th - September 8th. The Community Choice Awards will have one winner in each size-based category: small, medium, large, and super.

The determination of the winners will be based on the total number of votes received. The winners will be officially announced on September 27th. As one of the winning charities, HAWS would receive prominent visibility on Charity Navigator for one year and with Navigator's audience of donors, dedicated posts on Charity Navigator's social media as well as other opportunities to share our work and impact in the community and elevate the importance of animal welfare.
